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bu probably know some of the **pūrākau** of Māui, for example. The series filter will open up a checklist so you can choose 'school journals', etc.

6.For this example, I've chosen the series filter 'phonics plus' and then typed 'Kakano' into the search bar. All the texts in the Kakano series will show. You can toggle to 'list view' if you want to see a list of them.

7.You can find Aotearoa NZ Histories texts in the Connected ANZH section under 'series'

8. There are Google Slides with audio for the more recent School Journals and Connected Series. To find the Google Slides, select the School Journal and then click on the title of the article

The Google Slides version of the text will open and students can click on the audio symbols to hear text if they need that support.
